SUR SANGRAM — Singing Competition

Rules

- Contestants can participate in either Solo or Group
- Theme for the competition is Bollywood
- Group performance can have maximum 6 members
- The time duration for each performance is maximum 4 minutes, exceeding the time limit will lead to negative marking
- Maximum two minutes will be given to set up the stage
- Instruments are allowed for both solo and group performance
- One instrument will be allowed for solo performance

NRITYARAG — Dance Competition

Classical/Fusion/Contemporary

Rules

Group dance

- No props will be provided by the organizers. Participants should carry their own props
- Participants are solely responsible for their own equipment/props /belongings etc.
- Time limit is 4 minutes for each performance. There will be negative marking for exceeding the time limit
- Each team may have a maximum of 8 members for group performances
- The participants are requested to bring two pen drives to avoid technical disturbance, one of the pen drives to be given to the coordinator of the event in advance that can be collected post event.
- Dance performance should not convey any indecent gestures/ un parliamentary language
- The participants will be judged on the basis of their rhythm, formation, synchronization, expressions, costumes, makeup, setup and overall effects

- The decision of the judges will be final and binding

Solo Dance

- Time limit is 4 minutes for each performance. There will be negative marking for exceeding the time limit
- The participants are requested to bring two pen drives to avoid technical disturbance, one of the pen drives to be given to the coordinator of the event in advance that can be collected post event.
- The participants will be judged on their costumes, visual presentation and dance form
- Participants should get their own props
- Any obscene/offensive music/song is not allowed
- The decision of judges will be final and binding

PANACHE – Fashion Show

Rules

- It is a team event and team can comprise minimum of 6 members and maximum of 12 members.
- Any obscenity onstage will lead to immediate disqualification.
- Judging Criteria –
 1. Theme justification
 2. Background music

3. Makeup & attire
4. Stage set - up
5. Co - ordination of team members
6. Teams will be judged on costumes, theme, walking, stance and attitude.

- Each team would get 5 minutes for stage and background preparation
- Negative marking if teams exceed the time limit
- Green rooms will be provided
- Team members are requested to bring their own sound track in Pen drive.
